In order to be eligible for a grant, an organization must:

- Be actively working on the preservation and/or enhancement of coastal or estuary lands in the province of Nova Scotia, **and**
- Be registered as a charity with Canada Revenue Agency, **or**
- Create a formal partnership with a local charity or municipality to carry out the work supported by this grant.

In addition, eligible projects must include:

- An educational component that involves either the dissemination of information to the public/community or the active involvement of students in the project.
