### **Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible for this award, applicants must be enrolled in an approved and recognized Culinary Arts program in Nova Scotia or a member of one of the two CAFP Nova Scotia Student Branches and attending either Mount Saint Vincent University or St. Francis Xavier University. Applicants must have successfully completed a minimum of one year in one of these programs. Previous winners are not eligible.

### **Selection Criteria**

Student members who demonstrate Bob's dedication and interest in the foodservice industry and those who best represent the qualities that Bob brought to CAFP will be considered for the award.

### **Award Frequency**

One scholarship of \$2,000 will be awarded for each student category in 2012.
