## *A Scholarship Fund for business students at the Kingstec Campus, NSCC*

This award was created to honour Donald Lee Eagles (1923-2009) who taught business at the Kingstec campus for over two decades and retired in 1988. In his life, Donald embodied the values of discipline, hard work, independence, honesty, and integrity. These values, together with the love and support of his wife and family, brought him enormous success and happiness. In this way, Donald Lee Eagles represented the finest traditions of generations of Nova Scotians.

### **Who is eligible?**

To be eligible for this award, applicants must be enrolled full-time in the Business Administration program at the Kingstec campus.

### **What are the selection criteria?**

Applicants will be adjudicated upon the basis of their financial need and academic standing.

### **What is the value?**

One (1) **\$2,500** award is available. The award will be applied directly to the recipient's account at the Nova Scotia Community College. If there is no outstanding balance, a cheque will be issued to the student for other education-related expenses.

### **Is the Award Renewable?**

Typically scholarships will be awarded annually and will be renewable one time for a total of two academic years provided that the award recipient remains in good academic standing. However, the Donor reserves the right to award scholarships on a more or less frequent basis as income levels and the Foundation permit.
